

Youth Mobility Programs 2010

For German citizens:

have to be between 18 and 35 years of age, their application must be stamped as received by the Canadian Embassy in Berlin on or after their 18th birthday or prior to their 36th birthday;

are not accompanied by dependent family members (spouse, partner or children);

have the financial resources necessary to support themselves;

have not been convicted of a criminal offence;

are of good health;

have a valid passport and a return ticket or prove of sufficient funds at the Port of Entry to purchase a return ticket in Canada;

hold comprehensive liability and health insurance coverage valid for the duration of their stay.

The work permit has a validity of up to 12 months from the date you enter Canada .

Work & Travel

A twelve-month 'open' work & travel permit for young German citizens.

Young Workers

A twelve-month permit for young workers who are German citizens and who want to obtain training or work experience in their field of professional training.

Participants need an offer of employment made by a Canadian employer.
