Prepare

Review past inspection reports and known hazards before heading out

Be Systematic

Follow a route or checklist so nothing gets missed

Engage Workers

Ask about their concerns and observe tasks in action

Look Beyond the Obvious

Check less frequented areas (storage rooms, stairwells, etc)

Document Clearly

Note hazards, locations, and suggested actions

Follow Up

Confirm that corrective actions are completed

Industry Pro Tip:

In seasonal or fast-paced environments, pay attention to psychological hazards like time pressures, harassment, fatigue, and stress triggers (e.g., high guest volumes, extended shifts). Observing both physical and mental well-being helps prevent accidents and burn out.
